AGENDA ITEMS:

1. Opening comments

Mr. Lancho Rodríguez thanked everyone for participating and opened the meeting.

2. Traffic limiting for OSSKB

As traffic on the OSSKB continues to show increasing demand, and there are warnings regarding the misuse and exploitation of certain API features, limitations will be applied on the API endpoint to deny the file contents retrieval. These limitations will be applied from the first days of November.

3. STF presence at EclipseCon



On October 16 - 19, 2023, The Software Transparency Foundation was present at Ludwigsburg, Germany. Several Open Source Communities that includes STF services have shown their interest on the usage and contribution to the OSSKB.

4. CO2 footprint analysis proposal

Given the expressed interest and concern for sustainability and the need to obtain metrics for classifying open-source software components based on their level of CO2 emissions, Dr. Goñi has proposed an approach for evaluating Co2 footprint using Open Source Static Code Analysis tools. A PoC and its results will be presented on future meetings
